Financial Aid Regulations – Information for Applicants

General Information

The ISC has a fund for financial aid so that grants can be awarded on an annual basis. The actual number of grants to be awarded depends on the money that is available in this fund.

Amount of financial aid / Excess amount to be paid by applicant

The awarding of a financial aid is based on the annual tuition fees. This does not apply to the registration fee and lunch money. Generally an excess amount of at least EUR 175 per month is to be paid by the applicant for the tuition fees.

Duration of financial aid

Financial aids are only awarded for one school year at any one time.

Criteria for awarding financial aid

Prerequisite for the awarding of a grant is a fully completed financial aid application, as well as written documentation and an explanatory statement regarding the family's specific interest in the educational concept and profile of the school.

In general, financial aids are awarded according to social or financial criteria. The decisive factor is the family income (income of both parents):

- This should not exceed EUR 28,560 in the case of a single-parent family with one child.
- In the case of one-child families and partnerships, the income threshold increases to EUR 35,700 per year.
- In addition, the income threshold further increases by EUR 4,600 per year for each further child living in the same household as the applicant.
- Taxable income is regarded as the amount shown under point 245 on your annual salary statement or in case of foreign income, the defined taxable amount stated in your latest income tax return from the respective foreign country.
- In the case of self-employed persons, the last available income tax return (not older than 2 years) can be used as a basis for the calculation.
- In the case of families with two or more children, modifications can be made to the above-mentioned basis for calculation where required.

The following documents are to be included in the application:

- Annual salary statements (pay slips for the year) or income tax return from the previous calendar year.
- Cover letter / letter of motivation from the parent / guardian or pupil (as of the 6th school year)
